Lighting of the Candle Acknowledgement of land:

For thousands of years, First Nations people have walked on this land; their relationship with the land is at the centre of their lives and spirituality. As we gather, let us pause to remember that in



this region we live and work and worship on ancestral lands, on Treaty One Territory. Treaty One was established August 3, 1871, between the Annishinabe Swampy Cree and Ojibway with the Imperial Crown of Great Britain and Ireland.

These lands are the heartland of the Metis people. May we live with respect on this land and live in peace and friendship with its people.
